Trigger Finger Pathway

Start here

Primary Care

Mild

- Catching/click
- Pain
- Tender A1 pulley

Primary Care

Moderate

- Triggering
- Difficulty extending finger
- Need for passive finger extention
- · Loss of complete flexion

Reassurance

Patient information

Angalesia

Above plus:

- Steroid injection (consider using triamcinolone in view of evidence for more rapid effect)
- Review at 6 weeks

Perisistant symptoms:

- Repeat steroid injection
- Review at 6 weeks

Symptoms improve:

Discharge

Severe

· Fixed contracture

Persistant symptoms after 12 weeks and 2x injectons
